



Leek First School Remote Learning



The school may face a number of different remote learning scenarios over the next academic year. Each one will require a different approach to meeting the remote learning needs of the children however BGFL will be our main method of delivery for all classes except Reception. They will have email communication only.

- **An Individual child has to self-isolate**

This would be when a member of their family is either waiting for a test result or has had a positive result. The child would need to self-isolate for 14 days.

Individual learning emailed to parent/child to cover for the absent days ensuring that it matches what is being covered in school.

Access to BGFL (Not Reception)

- **A class bubble has to isolate**

This would be as a result of a suspected case or confirmed case in that bubble.

Children would need to isolate for fourteen days

Class learning emailed to parent/child daily

Access to BGFL (Not Reception) and other online resources

Video links uploaded daily to cover key learning areas in English/ maths of no more than thirty minutes. Staff to provide support and feedback.

- **Whole school Closure**

This would be as a result of multiple cases within multiple bubbles or a significant number of staff not in awaiting test results or confirmed cases. This could also be caused by a National closure.

Class learning emailed to parent and child daily.

Access to BGFL (Not Reception) and other online resources

Video links uploaded daily to cover key learning areas in English/ maths of no more than thirty minutes. Staff to provide support and feedback.
